DPW Director Mohammed Nuru Walk Through

On Friday, June 22, community representatives had the opportunity to meet with Department of Public Works Director, Mohammed Nuru and the Mayor's Fix-It Team to conduct a walk-through of Japantown. Main focus was the Buchanan Mall's Origami Fountain and cobblestone walkway. Safety of pedestrians walking on the cobblestone and the Fountains plumbing problems were identified.

Director Nuru suggest we should work towards a face lift that will once again highlight Ruth Asawa's Fountains and make the Buchanan Mall area an urban plaza that will attract visitors and locals alike.

He recommended that we look for a landscape architect, with experience and know-

how in Japanese culture and aesthetics, to help create a Master Plan for

improvements.








Community Ambassadors
