
On July 2 at the Hotel Kabuki, Japantown congratulated at that time Mayor-Elect, London Breed at a reception with over 200 well wishers from the community.

# JCBD receives anonymous donation towards implementation of security surveillance cameras in Japantown!

One of requests we have been hearing time and time again from those who live and work in Japantown is the need for cameras. The recent hike in car break-ins as well as homeless activities has put everyone in our community on edge. The JCBD and the Task Force have received numerous incident reports.

Late August the JCBD was notified by the Office of Economic Workforce Development that an anonymous donor has graciously committed to funding the implementation and one year maintenance of a security surveillance camera program within the CBD boundaries including the Japan Center Garage.

At the September 12th JCBD Board meeting you can find out more about this program and what it means to our community, businesses and property owners. Other CBDs (Union Square, Tenderloin, Lower Polk, Fisherman's Wharf) have already implemented security surveillance programs and have not only seen increase in arrests, but have been able to provide valuable video data to make convictions.
